### **Vaccine Schedule**

**1<sup>st</sup> visit:** Hepatitis B

**2 mos:** Pentacel(DTaP, Polio, Hib), Hepatitis B, Pneumococcal, Rotavirus

**4 mos:** Pentacel(DTaP, Polio, Hib), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus

**6 mos:** Pentacel(DTaP, Polio, Hib), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus

**9 mos:** Hepatitis B

**12 mos:** MMR, Varicella, Hepatitis A

*\*Hemoglobin test also done at this visit*

**15 mos:** DTaP, Hib, Pneumococcal

**18 mos:** Hepatitis A

*\*2 years: Hemoglobin test*

**4 years:** Quadracel(DTaP, Polio), MMR, Varicella

*\*Hemoglobin test also done at this visit*

**11 years:** Tdap, Meningococcal, HPV

**16 years:** Meningococcal #2

**17 years:** Meningococcal B

**18 years:** Tdap #2

*\*Flu vaccine is recommended yearly in children > 6 months of age*
